You can earn premium currency, gems, with the game or you can buy a lot at once. The ads were removed in an update some time ago, so you have only one honest ARPG to goodness here. Experience another fantastic ARPG for Android as you chase your enemy around the world. Eternium offers a lot to do, has a decent ending, and a good variety of gameplay.
